1917: This building was the first fireproof garage in Port Townsend.

1917: It was first occupied by Peninsula Motor Company of which Siebenbaum was a partner.

1922: Siebenbaum hired W. J. Buhler as manager in 1922. Mr. Buhler purchased the company and operated it as Buhler Motor Company until 1973.

1973: Lee Rea purchased the business and operated as Lee Rea Chevrolet and Oldsmobile.

1979: Two other auto-related businesses were in the building until 1981

1981: Robin Bergstrom's Antique and Classic Autos leased the site.
